Dear Granite City Business Owners:

I write to remind you that Granite City businesses are expected to comply with the Illinois Governor's Phase 4 Community Revitalization Order (Phase 4 Order) during the pandemic.

As you may know, the Illinois Governor's Office issued Executive Order 2020-48 on July 24, 2020. This Executive Order 2020-48 extends through August 22, 2020, the Illinois Governor's Executive Order 2020-43, the Phase 4 Community Revitalization Order (Phase 4 Order).

For all businesses, the Phase 4 Order of the Governor requires employees to maintain six-foot social distancing, and wear face coverings when social distancing is not possible. That Order further states customers and visitors are to be encouraged to wear face coverings when social distancing is not possible.

The Phase 4 Order of the Governor further requires hair salons, gymnasiums, and retail stores to limit occupancy to 50% capacity, in addition to the above requirements.

As Mayor, I have directed the Granite City Police Department to assist the Illinois State Police in the enforcement of the Governor's Executive Orders during this pandemic.

Of course, as rates of infection of COVID-19 rise or fall, the Governor's restrictions may change. To help ensure you comply with the most current of the Governor's Executive Orders, you can contact the Granite City Police Department.
