2012 Scattered Site Tree Removal

Separate sealed bids for the various Scattered Site Tree Removal will be received in the Mayor's Office, City of Granite City, at City Hall, 2000 Edison Avenue, Granite City, Illinois 62040, until **10:00 am Monday, August 13, 2012**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read. Sealed bids should be labeled "2012 SCATTERED SITE TREE REMOVAL" on the outside of the envelope.

Bids that are forwarded by mail shall be addressed to the Mayor's Office, City of Granite City, 2000 Edison Avenue, Granite City, IL 62040.

This work will consist of furnishing all labor, equipment and materials to complete the following:

Scattered Site Tree Removal

Tree and tree stump removal
Backfill at tree removal site
Debris removal and disposal

There will be no deposit required for copies of the plans and specifications.

Plans, specifications and contract documents may be obtained at the Office of the Mayor, City of Granite City, at City Hall, 2000 Edison Avenue, Granite City, IL 62040 beginning Monday, July 30, 2012.

For those not familiar with the area, a Public Works representative will provide a tour of each tree location on August 6, 2012 at 9:00 am, meeting at the Public Works office at 23rd & Adams Street.

The successful bidder will be required to execute and present a performance and payment bond in a sum equal to the full amount of the contract. Bids must be for the contract as a whole.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within ninety (90) days after the scheduled time of closing bids.

Federal law requires that contractors pay the prevailing wage rates as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.

All applicable laws, ordinances and rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract.

This project is subject to availability of project funds and compliance with requirements of Madison County Community Development.

The City of Granite City reserves the right to waive, or not waive, any irregularities in the bids and to reject any or all bids and to determine which is the lowest and best bid for the tree removal.
