**JACKSTADT CALLED MEETING TO ORDER.**

**JACKSTADT STATED FIRST THING WE WILL DISCUSS IS PRAIRIE FARMS REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT-TIME EXTENSION.**

**MAYOR STATED THAT PRAIRIE FARMS NEED EXTRA TIME FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT.**

**JACKSTADT STATED THAT THIS EVENING WE WILL BE VOTING ON A RESOLUTION FOR THE EXPANSION.**

**JACKSTADT STATED NEXT WE WILL BE DISCUSSING CARRON'S REIMBURSABLE EXPENSE APPROVAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$477,076.70 FOR TIFF REIMBURSEMENT.**

**JACKSTADT STATED THAT WE NEED TO APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION; THE COMPTROLLER HAS SAID THAT THIS IS MONEY OWED TO THEM.**

**JACKSTADT STATED THE LAST TO DISCUSS IS WEBER CHEVROLET, AN INDUCEMENT RESOLUTION. THE MAYOR RECEIVED A LETTER FROM WEBER CHEVROLET, GEORGE WEBER IV.**

**MAYOR STATED THAT MR. WEBER IS HERE TO TALK ABOUT THE EXPANSION, AND HE HAS SOME CREATIVE IDEAS.**

**MAYOR TURNED OVER TO MR. WEBER. MR. WEBER STATED THAT WEBER IS PLANNING AN EXPANSION, AS EXPLAINED IN HIS**

**LETTER. MR. WEBER STATED THAT THEY LOVE BEING IN THE CITY, AND THEY HOPE TO STAY FOR MANY YEARS TO COME. MR. WEBER STATED THAT HE THINKS THE NEW SHOWROOM WILL BRING A 15% TO 20% PER MONTH INCREASE. THIS IN TURN WILL HELP THE CITY.**
