Birdsong stated that he has lived in Granite City for 63 yrs; his home is at 2836 State Street across from the soft ball diamond; I suggest that we make one way parking around Wilson Park and angle the parking; this would make it easier for residents getting out of their cars; also it's a safety factor; I believe it's a good thing would create more parking.
