ALDERMAN JENKINS CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

JENKINS STATED THAT TONIGHT WE HAVE AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ALARM SYSTEMS WITHIN THE CITY.

JENKINS TURNED THE MEETING OVER TO CHIEF MILLER.

CHIEF MILLER EXPLAINED THE NEW ORDINANCE, THE REGISTRATION, THE REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO NEW SUBSCRIBERS AND THE FEES FOR THE FALSE ALARMS \$25.00 FOR RESIDENTS, AND \$50.00 FOR A BUSINESS. THE FIRST FALSE ALARM WOULD BY NOTIFICATION FROM CHIEF OF POLICE INCLUDING THIS FEE SCHEDULE, SECOND FALSE ALARM \$25.00, AND THE THIRD FALSE ALARM \$50.00 WOULD BY BILLED BY THE COMPANY. AT THE NEXT MEETING WE WILL NEED APPROVAL TO GET BIDS FOR THE BILLING COMPANY.

ATTORNEY KONZEN STATED THAT IT'S NOT A REVENUE MAKER FOR THE CITY, BUT IT IS MORE AN EFFICIENT WAY FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO HANDLE THE FALSE ALARMS. THE ORDINANCE DOES NOT TAKE EFFECT TILL JANUARY OF 2014.

JENKINS STATED THAT WE HAVE A REPORT FROM THE RED LIGHT CAMERA; WE HAVE HAD LESS VIOLATIONS AND INCIDENTS IN THIS AREA.

CHIEF MILLER EXPLAINED THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CONCEAL AND CARRY LAW AND THE POSSIBILITY OF NEW SHOOTING RANGE.

MOTION BY JACKSTADT, SECOND BY WILLIAMS TO ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
