**Alderman Pickerell called the Public Works Committee Meeting to order and turned over to the Mayor to discuss the Money from the sale of the cities collection system.**

**Mayor stated that with the money from the sale of the collection system the city would end up with 18 million. We have agreed to the contract with Illinois American Water, we are going to want to split up the money from the sale and would like to do some infrastructure work. Nameoki to Wabash has been allocated for this year. What I would like is for the council members to survey there areas and report back with problem areas. Six Million will go to pay off EPA loans; Six Million in funds will be used for the pension fund, set some funds aside some for infrastructure and a fund would set aside for storm sewer, possibly also purchasing a new street sweeper. Mayor stated that it is up to the Alderman how they would want to use the funds.**
