ALDERMAN THOMPSON CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

THOMPSON TURNED THE MEETING OVER TO MAYOR HAGNAUER.

MAYOR STATED THE THERE ARE SEVERAL ORDINANCES TONIGHT THAT THE COUNCIL NEEDS ACCEPT. MORRISON RD. FOUNDRING THAT WE HAD DISCUSSED IN THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS. MORRISON ROAD WILL VACATE ON THE 23RD, AND THE 25TH, THE ROAD WILL CLOSE. THE RAILROAD WAS GIVING 1.5 MILLION, \$600,000.00 FROM THE ICC, \$500,000.00 FROM THE COUNTY. THE ICC HAS COME DOWN FROM THE AMOUNT TO \$120,000.00 SO WE ARE APPROACHING OTHER S TO SUPPLEMENT THE DIFFERENCE IN THE FUNDING. WE CAN ALSO GET FOUNDRING FOR 3%-FOR 7 YEARS FOR \$29,000.00 TO \$30,000.00 A YEAR. MAYOR STATED THE BONUS FOR US IS TO FIX MARYVILLE RD. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$480,000.00 AND WE WOULD USE \$150,000.00 IN THE MFT TAXES. FOUNDRING WILL HELP WITH THE DRAINAGE PROBLEM AND OTHER ROAD ISSUES.
