THE HANDICAP PARKING AT 3221 KILARNEY, 3252 CARLSON AND
2402 WINTER. MOTION CARRIED.**

**MOTION BY THOMPSON, SECOND BY DAVIS FOR DONALD
KALTMAYER TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL. MOTION CARRIED.**

THOMPSON TURNED OVER TO KALTMAYER.

**KALTMAYER STATED THAT PEOPLE ARE TURNING AROUND IN
HIS DRIVEWAY CONSTANTLY, HE PLACED CONES IN THE DRIVE
AND THEY DRIVE OFF WITH THE CONES. KALTMAYER STATED
THAT HE IS HERE ASKING FOR HELP.**

**ALDERMAN MCDOWELL STATED THAT THE MAN IS ASKING FOR
OUR HELP THIS HAS BEEN GOING ON FOR ONE YEAR, 30-40 CARS A
DAY TURN AROUND IN THE DRIVEWAY AND THE MAN IS ASKING
FOR OUR HELP. THE CITY HAS GIVEN HIM 3-4 SETS OF CONES AND
THE PEOPLE DRIVE OFF WITH THEM UNDER THEIR CARS.**

**THOMPSON STATED IS THE ANSWER TO HIRE A POLICEMAN TO
STAY THERE ALL DAY LONG. THOMPSON STATED UNTIL WE GET
AMOS A 2-WAY STREET WE WILL HAVE THESE PROBLEMS.**

WILLIAMS STATED THAT OUR HANDS ARE TIED UNTIL WE GET THE GO AHEAD FROM THE OVERPASS PROJECT BEING FINISHED.

MCDOWELL STATED THAT AMOS BEING A 2-WAY WILL NOT FIX THE PROBLEM PEOPLE WILL STILL TURN AROUND TO GET TO THE OVERPASS.

KAMBARIAN STATED THAT MOST PEOPLE RESPECT THE LAW, UNFORTUNATELY I DON'T KNOW WHY THE PEOPLE WANT TO GO DOWN THE ONE WAY STREET THE WRONG WAY AND I HONESTLY DON'T KNOW WHAT WILL STOP THE PEOPLE FROM TURNING AROUND IN THE DRIVEWAY.
