

**CITY COUNCIL  
MINUTES  
JUNE 3, 2008**

**Mayor Ed Hagnauer called the regular meeting to order of the city council at 7:20 p.m.**

**ATTENDANCE ROLL CALL: Skubish, Hess, McDowell, Skoklo, Davis, Thompson, Partney, Smith, Whitaker, Wofford, Schmidtke, Jenkins, Eavenson and Clerk Whitaker and Mayor Hagnauer present. Kambarian was absent.**

**MOTION by Davis, second by Eavenson to approve the city council minutes for the previous meeting on May 20, 2008. Motion Carried.**

**MOTION By McDowell, second by Partney to approve as requested by the United Steelworkers, the Climate Awareness Walk on June 24, 2008 under the supervision of the Police Department. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Skoklo, second by Whitaker to approve as requested by the Greater Madison County Federation of Labor AFL~CIO, the annual Labor Day Parade on Monday September 1, 2008, under the supervision of the Police and Street Department. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Eavenson, second by Davis to concur with the recommendation of Joe Juneau and the City of Granite City accept the Street, Hunters Point Dr. in Phase One of the Sub-Division Hunters Point.**

**MOTION By McDowell, second by Whitaker to award the bid for demolition of 1746 State Street to Wayne's Hauling Inc., in the amount of \$9500.00, with the condition that work on Washington Ave. from previous job is corrected first.**

**MOTION By Thompson, second by McDowell to award the 2008 Paving Program- Material Letting Bids to: Maclair Asphalt Sales \$44.00/ton-\$364,408.00 for HMA Surface Course, Mix C, N50 and Charles E. Mahoney Company -\$52.00/ton-\$22,880.00 for Cold Mix M-120.**

**MOTION By Schmidtke, second by Whitaker to place on file the memo from the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, regarding the hiring of 3 probationary Firefighters/ Paramedics once all testing is done. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Hess, second by Wofford to renew the EAP Contract with Gateway Regional Medical Center in the amount of \$3843.75.**

**ROLL CALL: Skubish, Hess, Skoklo, Davis, Thompson, Partney, Smith, Whitaker, Wofford, Schmidtke, Jenkins and Eavenson voted yes and McDowell abstained. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Skoklo, second by Whitaker to authorize the Mayor and his staff to bring forth the necessary paperwork to accept the gift of the property at 2125 Delmar and forgive the demolition lien provided the current property owner or their insurance settles damage claim for adjacent property. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Hess, second by McDowell to approve the Bill List for May 2008, in the amount of \$2,037,664.71.**

**ROLL CALL: Skubish, Hess, McDowell, Skoklo, Davis, Thompson, Smith, Whitaker, Wofford, Schmidtke, Jenkins and Eavenson voted yes and Partney voted no. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Hess, second by Thompson to approve the Payroll for the period ending May 30, 2008 in the amount of \$586,345.49.**
