CITY COUNCIL  
OCTOBER 2, 2007**

**Mayor Ed Hagnauer called the regular meeting to order of the City Council at 7:05 p.m.**

**ATTENDANCE ROLL CALL: Skubish, Kambarian, McDowell, Skoklo, Davis, Thompson, Partney, Smith, Whitaker, Wofford, Schmidtke, Jenkins, Eavenson, Mayor Hagnauer and Clerk Whitaker present. Hess absent**

**MOTION By Jenkins, second by Eavenson to approve the city council minutes for the previous meeting on September 18, 2007. Motion carried.**

**MAYOR Hagnauer requested the approval of a block party for the 3200 Block of Erin Dr. on Sunday, October 14, 2007 under the supervision of the police department and street department.**

**MOTION By Eavenson, second by Davis to approve the request of the 3200 Block of Erin to hold a Block Party on October 14, 2007 as requested. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By McDowell, second by Kambarian to place on file the Plan Commission Agenda for October 4, 2007. Motion carried.**

**Motion By Skubish, second by Partney to apply the Omnibus Rule and approve the following Resolutions for demolition or repair of a dangerous or unsafe building located at:**

**MOTION By Thompson, second by Davis to have Ordinances brought in for stop signs at 2809 Edgewood and 2312 Elm St. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Kambarian, second by Whitaker to approve a Resolution to solicit bids for a new sewer vacuum truck and a Resolution to solicit bids for replacing twelve lift station panels.**

**ROLL CALL: Skubish, Kambarian, McDowell, Skoklo, Davis, Thompson, Smith, Whitaker, Wofford, Schmidtke, Jenkins and Eavenson. Partney voted no. Motion carried.**

**MOTION By Kambarian, second by Thompson to approve the Bill List for September 2007 in the amount of \$3,046,537.32.**

**Alderman Partney changed his vote on the motion to approve a Resolution to solicit bids for a new sewer vacuum truck and a Resolution to solicit bids for replacing twelve lift station panels from no to yes.**

**MOTION By Skoklo, second by Wofford to adjourn the regular City Council Meeting at 7:45 p.m. Motion carried.**
