**SKOKLO CALLED MEETING TO ORDER.**

**SKOKLO TURNED OVER FERRY. FERRY DISCUSSED THE GATEWAY REGIONAL HOSPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND RENOVATION. FERRY STATED THAT THEY WOULD BE DOING THINGS INSIDE, OUT AND PARKING AREA. GATEWAY WOULD LIKE TO HAVE THE INDUCEMENT RESOLUTION ON FILE. MORE DISCUSSION BY THE COUNCIL ABOUT THE INDUCEMENT RESOLUTION.**

**MOTION BY THOMPSON, SECOND BY JACKSTADT TO APPROVE THE INDUCEMENT RESOLUTION FOR GATEWAY REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER. MOTION CARRIED.**

**SKOKLO STATED THAT WE WOULD DISCUSS VACATION REQUEST OF 21<sup>ST</sup>. ST. SKOKLO TURNED OVER TO THE MAYOR HAGNAUER.**

**MAYOR HAGNAUER STATED THAT HE HAD MET WITH THE HOSPITAL, AND THE DISCUSSED TEARING DOWN THE BUILDING, AND MAKING THE CENTER AREA A PARKING LOT. GATEWAY WOULD LIKE TO VACATE ALLEY AREA WASHINGTON TO LEE AVE TO 21<sup>ST</sup> OF WASHINGTON. MORE DISCUSSION ABOUT THE COUNCIL ABOUT THE STREET VACATION REQUEST BY THE COUNCIL. GATEWAY TOLD THE MAYOR THAT IF THEY DIDN'T GET THE CENTER AREA THAT WOULD HAVE A SHORTAGE OF PARKING. SCHMIDTKE ASKED WOULD THIS INTERFERE WITH THE EMERGENCY VEHICLES RESPONSE TIME. MAYOR HAGNAUER STATED THAT SOMETIME WE WILL HAVE TO ADDRESS THE WHOLE AREA DOWN THEIR ACCIDENTS, SEWER BRAKES ETC.**

**FERRY STATED THAT THE HEALTH CARE FOUNDATION SHOULD START CONSTRUCTION THIS SUMMER WITHOUT THE EXTRA PARKING THERE WOULD BE A SEVIER PARKING SHORTAGE. SKOKLO STATED HIS CONCERN IS DO WE NEED TO ADDRESS THE CHANGE IN THE DIRECTION FLOW OR LOOK AT ADDRESSING SOMETHING LIKE THAT JUST MAKE IT MORE CONDUCTIVE WITH THE TRAFFIC. THOMPSON ASKED ABOUT THE REMAINING HOUSES ON WASHINGTON, COULD THAT AREA POSSIBLY BE USED AS PARKING. MAYOR STATED THE PEOPLE DON'T WANT TO SELL THEM. MAYOR HAGNAUER STATED THAT HE THINKS WE SHOULD VACATE FROM THE ALLEY TO BE SAFE, AND WE MAY HAVE TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE HOME OWNERS.**

**MOTION BY THOMPSON, SECOND BY JACKSTADT TO VACATE THE ALLEY FROM WASHINGTON TO LEE AVE TO WASHINGTON AVE ON 21<sup>ST</sup>. STREET. MOTION CARRIED.**

**MAYOR ASKED THAT WHEN THE COMMITTEE CHAIRS BRING A RESOLUTION OR AN ORDINANCE BEFORE THE COMMITTEE, HE ASKED IF THEY COULD VOTE ON IT. THIS WOULD PUBLIC IN KNOWING THAT THE GROUP MEET DISCUSSED THE MATTER AND EITHER ACCEPTED OR REJECTED IT.**
